The Trojans began their season with Middle Tennessee State University. Pitcher Mike Mills hurled 9 strong innings in the season opener. Freshman Kenny Hamilton relieved and took the loss in the 11th inning. Next, TNC defeated Fisk as Kevin Sanderson went the distance in his first start in 2 years. The Tropgans won the second game of the double-header against Athens State in which TNC erupted for 19 hits. In a close game, Trevecca and TSU blasted away at each other, hitting a total of 8 home runs. The Trogans emerged victorious behind shots by Wayne Puckett, Rose Burrell, Rodney Jackson, and two by Mark Brown. The Trojans then racked up wins against Pensacola Christian, Mt. Vernon, and CBC. In an exciting game against LeMoyne-Owen, Kenny Hamilton got his third win with a two-hit shut out, striking out a school record 17 men. Trevecca followed this with wins against Bethel, Lambuth, Freed-Hardeman, University of the South and LeMoyne-Owen again. In a 7-3 victory over Union, Senior Steven Dahlhauser hit a 2-run homer and the Trogans claimed second place in the VSAC and a berth in the conference tournament. The Trojans finished a successful season with 28 wins and 13 losses.





























Sweet Success










The service was one of total rejoicing and thankfulness to God. Hearts were stirred as Trevecca's dream of shaking off the debt was realized.



The celebration and the good times that brought pride to every Trojan will never be forgotten.





















\$7,000 In 24 Hours, Worth It All!
