Papua New Guinea

The island nation of Papua New Guinea (PNG) has known centuries of complex foreign rule, and has been a divided nation under German, British, and Australian governance, until it gained independence from Australia in 1975. It is still part of the Commonwealth of Nations with the British monarch as Head of State. PNG is noted to be one of the world's most linguistically diverse nations, boasting 839 languages. The work of the Church of the Nazarene officially started in 1955. Ten of the 17 districts are accessible by road and seven districts by air. While PNG has 22 provinces, the church has gone into 18 provinces. Until recently, the Church of the Nazarene had yet to reach four provinces; but with the establishment of a pioneer area encompassing these remaining four provinces, the Church is now present and active in all 22 provinces of PNG. The majority of the population have little educational background, though it is estimated that half of the population is under the age of 25 years. Modern technology is not available in many areas. These realities present both challenges and opportunities for the Church of the Nazarene as it seeks to minister effectively throughout the country.
